Future Innovator Challenge Submission Guidelines

Submissions can contain any combination of paragraphs, point form, diagrams, or illustrations, but they must include:

Cover page, containing:

- Project name
- Name of the school/s you and your team attend (and your specific cohort if appropriate)
- Team members' names and email addresses
- The Challenge Theme and Problem Statement addressed by your project

Overview: A compelling introductory paragraph explaining exactly what your project will do, why it is unique, and what problem it addresses

Problem: Analyze the problem, demonstrate a solid understanding of why it exists

Solution: What is your proposed solution, how will it address the problem?

Technology: Smart South Island is all about how to use data and connected technologies to solve problems. Describe the technologies behind your solution. Which platforms and/or data sources or data collecting methods do they use? How did the end-user impact which platform or approach to technology that was chosen? How could the solution be scaled to other neighborhoods, cities, or groups?

Implementation & Feasibility: What is your implementation plan? How will you encourage people to adopt your solution and buy into your idea? This section should include to how you plan to spend the prize money if you win (i.e. design a pilot project to test your hypothesis).
